Mr. Larry B. Stegall, 79, of Price, passed away Sunday, Sept. 23, 2018 in Timpson. The family will receive friends for a celebration of his life from 10:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, Sept. 29, 2018 at the South Main Church of Christ in Henderson.
