



## Lukas Miron Foppes

June 4, 1932 - June 1, 2010

A memorial service and life celebration for Lukas Miron Foppes, 77, of Henderson, will be held at 2:00 p.m. Saturday, June 5, 2010 at St. Matthews Episcopal Church with The Rev. Patsy Barham officiating under the direction of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home in Henderson. Mr. Foppes died June 1, 2010 at his residence. He was born June 4, 1932 in Waterville, New York and has been a resident of Henderson for the last thirteen years. He was a member of St. Matthews Episcopal Church and was a retired project manager in San Jose, CA. Mr. Foppes served in the US Navy from 1951-1955 and was a veteran of the Korean War. He also taught and was a pilot for Cessna Aircraft. He received his teaching certificate from the University of California at Berkley and was a band director and a skilled artist and musician. Mr. Foppes served as a member of the Kilgore College Scholarship Advisory Committee and was a member of the East Texas Steel Guitar Association. He had an electronic patent through RCA and worked in the computer industry in the Silicon Valley, CA as a programming manager for new releases. He was also very active in local theater at the Henderson Civic Theater.
