Mrs. Lula Marie Brooks Sullivan, 101, of Henderson, passed from this life on February 17, 2025, at Pine Lodge Assisted Living Home with her loving family by her side. She was born October 12, 1923, in the Liberty Community of Rusk County to the late Stephen and Essie (Freeman) Brooks. At an early age, Marie made a public profession of faith while attending Liberty Missionary Baptist Church.

Mrs. Sullivan spent most of her life in Marshall where she worked as an engineer for the Texas Department of Transportation. Marie retired from TxDOT in 1984 at the young age of 60 after 40 years of service. She attended Cumberland Presbyterian Church in Marshall where she was involved in all phases of church work. Mrs. Sullivan moved home to Henderson in 2000 and became a member of First Methodist Church. Marie had also been a member of the Texas Employment Association.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband Robert Leo Sullivan Jr, brothers Wesley, Rossie, Otis, and Louin Brooks, and sisters Dorothy Brooks Wood, Essie Faye Brooks Little, and Jessie Mae Brooks Williams.

Survivors include several nieces and nephews, cousins, other family and friends.
