



Mr. Luther Keitt

June 11, 1930 - May 6, 2015

Memorial services for Mr. Luther Keitt, 84, of Henderson will be held at 2 pm Saturday, May 9, 2015 at First Baptist Church of Henderson, with Dr. David Higgs officiating under the direction of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home. The family will receive friends following the service in The Family Life Center at the church.

Mr. Luther Keitt passed away Wednesday, May 6, 2015 in Henderson at his home. He was born June 11, 1930 in Hubbard, Texas. He graduated from The University of Texas in 1950 and began his banking career at First State Bank of Hubbard. He moved from Hubbard in 1965 to become President of Citizens National Bank in Henderson and served there until he retired in 1992.

Thereafter, he continued serving as an individual consultant until the end of 2001. He had the honor of serving on the boards of the Texas Bankers Association and American Bankers Association. He served in the Lions Club in Henderson from 1965 until 2010. He was also a member of First Baptist Church where he taught Sunday School for many years.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Aylmer and Pauline Keitt.

Survivors include his wife, Faye Keitt of Henderson; sister, Camille Keitt and longtime friend of the family Dr. Maria-Luisa Urdaneta of Austin, TX; daughter, Beth Brubaker and husband Jim of Spring, TX, son Brad Keitt and wife Paige

of Henderson, daughter Susan Gorney and husband Mike of Nashville, TN, and daughter Melanie Morris and husband Paul of Henderson; grandchildren, Christian Patterson and husband Chase of Kilgore, Collyn Keitt, Madeline Morris, and Adam Morris of Henderson, and Anna Gorney and Rush Gorney of Nashville, TN; along with many other loving friends and family.

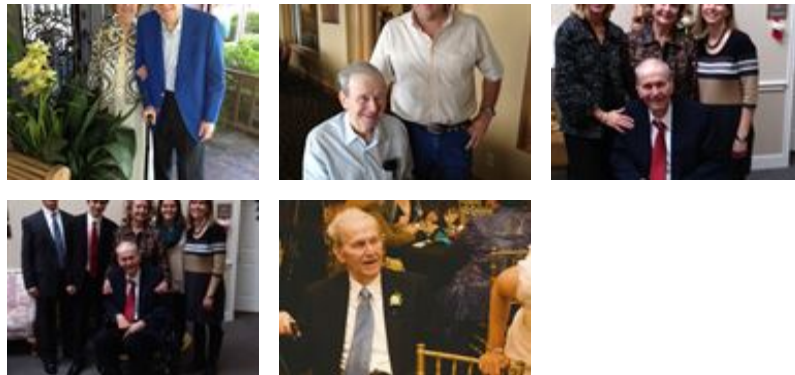
