Funeral services for Ottie Mabel Taliaferro Hinson will be held on the 13th day of March, 2012, at 4:00 o'clock p.m., in the chapel of Crawford - A. Crim Funeral Home, with the Rev. Mrs. Hinson passed away on March 10, 2012, in Henderson, Texas, at the age of 92 years. Mabel was born on August 31, 1919, in Henderson, Texas, to Robert Edward Taliaferro, Sr. and Ottie Strickland Taliaferro, and was a lifelong resident of Rusk County. She graduated from Gaston High School, attended business school in Tyler, Texas, and then married her husband of nearly 50 years, Ottis Herrington. Later, she became a licensed vocational nurse and worked for Dr. C. L. McShan for over 20 years. Many residents of Henderson still recall her cheerful and compassionate care. In 1993, she married Maurice Hinson. She was a member of the First Methodist Church of Henderson, the Henderson Woman's Forum, and the Modern Study Club, as well as a dedicated member of the AARP "game day" group. Mabel was preceded in death by her parents, her brother, Robert Edward Taliaferro, Jr., and her husbands, Ottis Herrington and Maurice Hinson.
