Marilyn passed away Wednesday, September 9, 2014, at Longview Regional Hospital after a long and courageous battle with cancer.

She loved sharing stories about her childhood and growing up in a close-knit Christian family across the street from the Hunt Oil Camp. She was very proud of her lifetime membership in Beta Sigma Phi Sorority.
