



Mrs. Mary Ann Chapman

November 18, 1923 - January 3, 2024

A celebration of the life of Mrs. Mary Ann Chapman, 100, of Henderson, will be held at 2:00 p.m., Saturday, January 6, 2024, at First Presbyterian Church of Henderson with Rev. Michele Goff officiating. The family will receive friends following the service in the Fellowship Hall at the church. A private, family committal service will be held at Bridges Cemetery under the direction of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home.

Mrs. Chapman passed from this life on January 3, 2024, in Tyler. She was born November 18, 1923, in the Pine Hill community to the late Tom and Ruby (Milam) Smith. Mrs. Chapman graduated from Henderson High School in 1941. She worked several places in downtown Henderson, including Wright's Pharmacy, Wright-Dyer Drug store, and The Card Cottage Hallmark store which she co-owned with Davis Scoggins. She was a member of First Presbyterian Church of Henderson and was a former member of Willow Springs Presbyterian Church in the Chapman Community.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband of 59 years James Floyd Chapman who she married on December 13, 1941, one week after Pearl Harbor, and two brothers Wilson Smith and James Henry Smith.

Those left to cherish her memory are her children, Jimmy Chapman of

Henderson, and Joy Andrews and husband Randy of Longview; grandchildren, Jay Andrews and Misti Smith of White Oak, and James Andrews and wife Amy of Argyle; great-grandchildren, Ellie and Asher Andrews of Argyle; sister, Robbie Jo Brooks of Arlington; and numerous nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.
