December 29, 1920 - March 9, 2010

Funeral services for Mary Alice Sides (Mrs. J.P. Sides) will be held on Saturday, March 13, 2010, at 10:00 a.m. at Calvary Baptist Church in Henderson with the Rev. Frank Vaughan conducting the services. A second service will follow at 2:00 p.m. at Rocky Springs Baptist Church in Dialville, Texas with Rev. Charles Swilling conducting the services. Interment will be at Rocky Springs Cemetery in Dialville under the direction of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home in Henderson. Mrs. Sides died on March 9, 2010, at the age of 89, after a brief illness. Visitation will be at Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home from 5-7 p.m. Friday, March 12, 2010. Pallbearers will be grandchildren and nephews of Mrs. Sides. Mrs. Sides was born on December 29, 1920, the fourth of five children and the youngest daughter of George and Mary Alice (Rainey) Harris. She married her Dialville High School sweetheart, J.P. Sides on February 13, 1944, at First Baptist Church in Jacksonville, Texas. While Mr. Sides was on military duty in Europe during World War II, Mrs. Sides worked in the Cherokee County Clerk's office in Rusk, Texas. In 1950, Mr. and Mrs. Sides moved to Henderson where they have remained for 60 years. Mrs. Sides was a stay-at-home mother to three children, Steve, Karen, and Shaefer. She was an active member of Calvary Baptist Church in Henderson. Preceding her in death were her parents and all of her siblings: sisters Erma Harris, Irene Durrett, and Lucille Phillips, and her brother Nolan Harris. Survivors include her husband of 66 years, J. P. Sides, and her three children and their spouses: Steve and Linda Sides of Hallsville, Karen and Jim

Grunert of Cleburne, and Shaefer and Amy Sides of Lorena; grandchildren, Jay Sides, Lisa Sides Tabor and husband Josh, Jaimie Grunert Moss and husband Steve, Jonathan Grunert, Justin Grunert, Sarah Sides, Mary Sides, and Samantha Collins; great-grandchildren, Anna and Julian Tabor.
