Funeral services for Mildred Turner, 81, of Henderson, will be at 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, Feb. 2, at the Crawford - A. Crim Funeral Home chapel with Mark Headrick and Jason Taylor officiating. Interment will follow at Lakewood Memorial Park under the direction of Crawford - A. Crim Funeral Home. Mrs. Turner died on Thursday, Jan. 27, 2011 at a local nursing home. She was born on Dec. 21, 1929 in Houlka, Miss., and lived most of her life in East Texas. Mildred attended the First Freewill Baptist Church. Mildred was involved in the livestock auction business with brothers Don and PeeWee Forrester as their primary bookkeeper in Athens, Emory, and Henderson for 45 years. She served as the office manager at all three barns as well as overseeing other business ventures with the Forrester's Cattle Company. Through her years of service she developed a very special bond that lasted a lifetime. In addition to the Forresters, she had a special friendship with Julio Ramirez, another longtime employee who was always there to assist Mildred with whatever she asked of him.
