He also cherished all the time he got to spend with his family, and enjoyed spoiling them all. Milton was a member of Selman City Christian Church and loved to serve in any way he could, including serving as both an Elder and Deacon, made the coffee, mowed the lawn, and brought donuts

among many other things. He was the epitome of charity, and would help anyone in need, whether it was someone on the side of the road, in need of a handout, or through organizations such as St. Jude's.

Milton was preceded in death by his wife of 61 years, Walta Allen; and his parents, Tommy and Mary Allen.

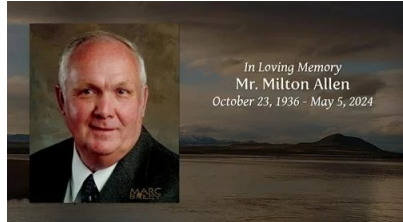
