Ding Ding, as she was known, enjoyed the love and affection of her kids long after they were grown and had kids of their own. Many stayed in touch with her by phone calls, cards, and visits. She loved her kids and they loved her. She set an example; a good example!

Her first love on this earth was her family. Although persons of limited education and mean, she and her beloved husband of 49 years, Rayford created a home that was full of love, caring, and direction. Their sons and their wellbeing were the focus of their lives. They made God part of their family.

Nadine was preceded in death by her parents, Tommy and Cora Lee Young; brothers, Jessie Young, John Henry Young, Preston (Pete) Young, J. T. Young Jr., and Rev. Charles Young; sisters, Mary Lou Bailey, Mamie Lois Nations, Dolly York, Ann Trimble, Bonnie Marie Brewer, and an infant sister.

She is survived by two sons, Tommy Berry and wife Terry of Henderson, Bobby Berry and wife Margaret of Buda, TX. 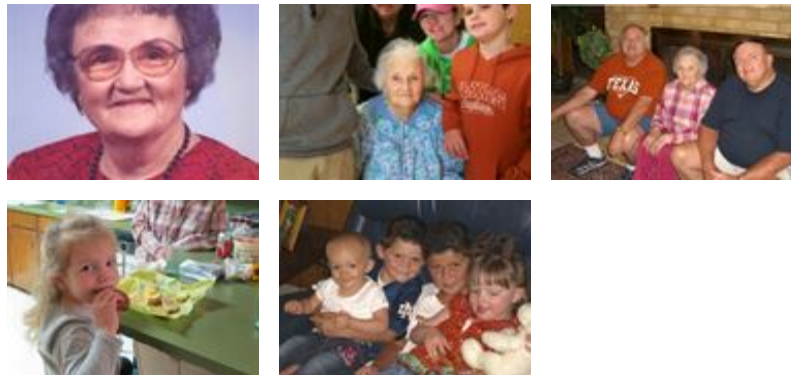
