Funeral services for Nell Ray Hall Velvin will be held at 10:00 a.m. Friday March 12, 2010 at Crawford A. Crim Funeral Home with Bro. Bill Kuykendall officiating. Visitation will be from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. Thursday, March 11, 2010 at the funeral home. Burial will be in Lakewood Memorial Park. Born in Jonesboro, Louisiana, February 14, 1923, to Willie C. and Annie P. Koonce Hall, she died Tuesday, March 9 at Mother Frances Hospital. She moved to Carlisle, Texas in 1931 when her father was transferred with the Ohio Oil Company. She married Edgar G. Velvin in 1940 and moved to Henderson where she remained for 70 years. Her grandchildren, their friends and parents, fondly called her Gran Nell. Sporting events were a favorite entertainment especially when her family was involved. In 2007 she was named "Fan of the Year" by the Henderson Lion Football Booster Club. She especially loved the annual family ski trip where she was a spectator and there to join the fun. An active woman, many said "Go" was her middle name. She was known to get up at 5:00 in the morning and dress, complete with make-up and jewelry, so she would be ready for whatever came up. She enjoyed visiting and being around people so much that she never fully retired from her full-time, then part-time job at Velvin Oil Company, the family business. She cared about others and wanted to know how they were and what they were doing in their lives. Always ready to listen, she also offered comments, advice or opinions. No one had to wonder what she was thinking because she told them. She was preceded in death by her parents and

husband Edgar G. Velvin of 44 years. She is survived by children David Velvin and wife Jo and Becky Jordan and husband Jim of Henderson. Grandchildren are Jeremy, Dusty, Jared and wife Rachel and great-granddaughter Brooklyn. Also surviving is her sister Peggy Hopkins and husband Bev of Dallas. Nieces are Lynda Jo Sawyer of Dallas and Susan Standifer of Longview.
