She was active in her local Republican Party activities and was very interested in politics and social issues. Neva was famous for her holiday dinners, especially her recipe for cornbread dressing, which she inherited from her mother and grandmother and which has thankfully been passed down. Neva loved family get togethers

and was always an excellent hostess. She had a gentle and generous spirit. Neva was happily married to Bobby Poland till his untimely death in an oilfield accident when she was a young mother of two small boys, Rick and Mike. Several years later she remarried. Her second husband was Joe Silvers. They were happily married for over 40 years. Joe passed away earlier this year, so she was twice widowed.

She was preceded in death by: parents, Eldridge Clinton and Ruby Lee Williams Wynn; husbands, Bobby Poland, the father of her children, and Joe Silvers; and her brothers, Harold Wynn, Bill Wynn, and Pete Wynn.
