Miss Norma Marie Markey passed from this life on Wednesday, the 24th of June, 2015, in Liberty, Missouri. Services will be held at St. Jude's Catholic Church on Tuesday, June 30th at 2:00 p.m. Visitation will be held on Monday evening from 6-7 p.m., and Rosary from 7-8 p.m., with Father Jay Lucas presiding, at Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home of Henderson.

Norma was born in Henderson, TX, on November 1, 1931 to the late Frank Henry Markey and Vernie Marie Theriot Markey. She graduated from St. Vincent Academy in Shreveport, LA., then attended Tyler Junior College. She finished her education at St. Thomas University in Houston. She earned a degree in both music and education. After college, she taught at St. Anthony's school in Houston. While at TJC, she was a duchess in the Tyler Rose Festival. Finally, Norma responded to the call of God and joined Infant Jesus Monastery in Lufkin and became a christened Nun. She spent three and one half years in the convent and then retired to a nursing home due to health reasons.

She spent most of her time in prayer and meditation. She always said Our Lady of Mercy Country Home was "heaven on earth." 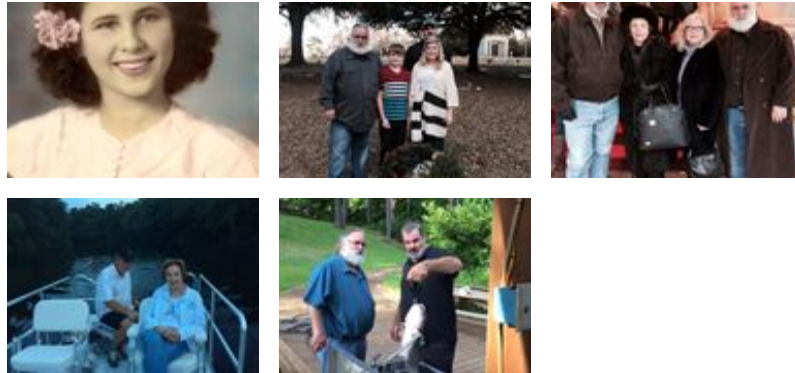
