Funeral services for Ottis E. Brooks, 90, of the Chapman community, will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday, July 31, 2010, at Blossom Hill United Methodist Church with Rev. Matthew Thomasson and Rev. Mr. Brooks died July 27, 2010, at Hospice of East Texas Homeplace. He was born March 1, 1920, in Jasper. He spent most of his life in Chapman. He was a member of Blossom Hill United Methodist Church and was a retired welder from Eastman Kodak. Mr. Brooks was a rancher and farmer. He spent most of his life hunting and fishing, and he loved his bird dogs, and he was a member of the National Rifle Association. He was also a 52-year master mason at Pine Hill Lodge No. 95 where he was a past worshipful master. He fought in World War II and was a veteran of the Marines, and he was a member of VFW Post 8535.
