



Ottis "Pete" Branham

December 6, 1925 - May 9, 2013

Funeral services for Ottis 'Pete' Branham, 87, of Henderson, will be at 2:00 p.m., Saturday, May 11, 2013 at Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home chapel with Pastor Chris Proctor and his son-in-law, Dr. David L. Willis, Sr. officiating. Interment will follow with military graveside honors at New Salem Cemetery under the direction of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home of Henderson. Visitation will be from 5 - 7 p.m., Friday, May 10 at the funeral home. Mr. Branham passed away Thursday, May 9, 2013 at his residence. He was born Dec. 6, 1925 to William J. and Mae Branham in Rusk County. Pete served in the US Army in the European Theatre during WWII, earning two Bronze Stars, and was held as a POW from Jan. - Apr. 1945. He also served the people of Rusk County, Pct. 5, as Constable for eight and a half years, and served first as a policeman and then Police Chief for nineteen and a half years for the city of New London, and retired at the age of 75. He also served on the Laneville ISD School Board as member and President. He was a member and Deacon of New Salem Baptist Church since 1949. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his son, James Earl Branham; grandson, James Earl Branham; brother, Samuel D. 'Buck' Branham; four sisters, Orphie Branham, Faye Whitehead, Ovis Sonier, and Wilma Hale. Survivors include: his wife of 67 years, Loyce Louise Jolly Branham of New Salem; sons, Carol Lynn Branham and wife Evelyn of Navasota, and Jimmy Darrell Branham, Sr. and wife Mary of New Salem; daughter, Sandra Sue Willis and husband David of New Salem; sister, Corrine 'Dean' Holdeman of Ore City; eleven grandchildren

and sixteen great-grandchildren; beloved nieces and nephews, great-nieces and great-nephews, and a host of many dear friends. Pallbearers are the United States Army Honor Guard.
