



## Mrs. Patricia Major Neinast

March 20, 1919 - January 20, 2016

Graveside services for Mrs. Patricia Major Neinast, 96, of New London, will be held at 2 pm on Monday, January 25, 2016 at Lakewood Memorial Park. Interment will follow under the direction of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home.

The family will receive friends from 3-5 pm on Sunday, January 24 at the funeral home.

Mrs. Neinast passed from this life on January 20, 2016 at her residence. She was born March 20, 1919 in Baytown and has lived in New London for over 60 years. Patricia was a member of the Order of Eastern Star and served the Grand Chapter of Texas as Worthy Grand Matron in 1974-1975. She had served in several positions including Grand Warder in 1963-1964, and Grand Examiner for six years previous to being elected Associate Grand Conductress in 1971 to complete her service to Grand Chapter presiding over the "Roads To Remember" 93rd Annual Grand Chapter session in Dallas, Texas October 6-9, 1975. Her favorite charity consisted of each chapter in Texas having a garage sale to donate to the cost of placing kidney dialysis machines in each district in Texas, two in some. These machines were placed in areas that had no dialysis machines available without having to drive several hours. Mrs. Neinast was also a member of New London Methodist Church.

She was preceded in death by her parents, and husbands E.A. Major and A.G. "Dick" Neinast.

Survivors include her sons Michael B. Major and wife Laura of Wharton, and David Major and wife Judy of Forney, grandchildren Patrick Major, Leah Jurca, and Matthew Major, and three great-grandchildren.
