Funeral services for Ralph W. Ballenger, 93, of Henderson, will be held at 2 p.m. Friday, May 7, 2010, at Crawford-A. Crim Chapel with Rev. Bill Kuykendall and Rev. Frank Lane officiating. Interment will be in New Prospect Cemetery under the direction of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home in Henderson. Mr. Ballenger died Wednesday, May 5, 2010, at Hospice of East Texas, Tyler. He was born Oct. 14, 1916, in Rusk County and was a lifelong resident of Henderson. He was a member of New Prospect Baptist Church and retired from Grondike Transport. He was an active member of VFW. He joined the 425th Army Air Force Unit in Barksdale about a year before Pearl harbor. During the war, he earned several medals, including the Asiatic Pacific Campaign Medal with three Bronze Stars, a Good Conduct Medal, the American Defense Service Medal and the Distinguished Unit Badge. The highest rank he achieved during the war was staff sergeant. Family will receive friends from 6-8 p.m. Thursday, May 6, 2010, at the funeral home. He was preceded in death by: his wife, Vonzell Ballenger; parents, Clifton and Lois Ballenger; sister, Maureen Harris; brothers, Jack and Thomas Ballenger Sr. Survivors include: son, David Ballenger and wife Pam of Henderson; grandsons, Paul Ballenger, Shane Ballenger, Matt Ballenger and Jake Ballenger; nephews, Thomas Ballenger Jr. and Johnny Ballenger; great-nephew, Thomas Ballenger III, great-niece, Brooklyn Ballenger.
