



Mr. Ray Ludwig

February 12, 1934 - February 24, 2016

Funeral services for Mr. Ray Ludwig, 82, of Henderson, will be held at 10 am on Saturday, February 27, 2016 in the chapel of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home with Rev. Jerry Williams and Rev. Thomas A. Abney officiating. Interment will follow at Lakewood Memorial Park under the direction of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home.

The family will receive friends from 5-7 pm on Friday, February 26 at the funeral home.

Mr. Ludwig passed away February 24, 2016 at Autumn Leaves in Henderson. He was born February 12, 1934 in Houston to the late Theo and Gussie (Follett) Ludwig.

I know that I have talked to some of my friends about my grandfather, Ray Ludwig, but never in much detail. Now seems like an appropriate time to do so. Ray Ludwig was a brilliant Gospel songwriter and pianist, and a master of the Hammond B3 organ. He had a successful career as a studio musician, and was sought by numerous ensembles for his skill, as well as his peaceful touch at the keyboard. He was a close friend of Doris Akers, the famed Gospel singer and composer of "Sweet, Sweet Spirit," who I am told refused to allow most other keyboardists to accompany her! Throughout most of the 1970's, he worked closely with Jimmy Swaggart, playing the B3 before

massive congregations around the world. He was an innovator, developing unique sounds and techniques which organists still imitate to this day. He was a life-long evangelist who deeply affected countless lives, and refused to stop ministering through his music and praying for those around him until he could no longer continue. My Grandpa is a massive influence on the life and music of his entire family.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his son, Marvin Allen Ludwig.

Survivors include: wife, Jeannette Ludwig of Henderson; sons, Ray Ludwig, Jr., Gordon Kenneth Lockhart, Kenneth Wayne Ludwig, Robert James Lockhart, and Steven Charles Ludwig; daughters, Carol Webb, Brenda Smith, and Rae Marie Livsey; brother, Charles Theo Ludwig; 25 grandchildren and 24 great-grandchildren.

Pallbearers will be Ray Ludwig Jr., Kenny Ludwig, Robert Lockhart, Charles Livsey, Dennis Smith, and Steven Deatherage.
