Funeral services for Mr. Reed D. Hunsdorfer, 62, of the Shake Rag community, will be at 2:00 p.m., Thursday, March 8, 2012 at Crawford - A. Crim Funeral Home chapel with Rev. Matt Gholson officiating. Interment will follow at Zion Hill Cemetery under the direction of Crawford - A. Crim Funeral Home of Henderson. Mr. Hunsdorfer died Saturday, March 3, 2012 from injuries sustained in an automobile accident. He was born April 1, 1949 in Staten Island, NY. He got to East Texas "as fast as he could" and lived here for the last 30 years. He graduated from the University of Denver where he was a member of Alpha Kappa Psi. He worked locally as an assistant manager at Tractor Supply, and also was a co-owner of Cool Creek Farm. He attended the Ebenezer Missionary Baptist Church. Visitation will be from 6 - 8 p.m., Wednesday, March 7 at the funeral home. He was preceded in death by his parents, Lloyd and Eleanor Hunsdorfer; niece, Sarah Royce; and brother-in-law, James Royce.
