



Mrs. Robbie Smith Brooks

Robbie Jo Smith Brooks was born on March 23, 1927, in Henderson to the late Tom and Ruby Smith of Pine Hill, Texas. She was the youngest of four children. She graduated the 10th grade from the Pine Hill School and Henderson High School in 1944.

On May 3, 1946, Robbie married the love of her life, Harley Brooks. They had two children, Mike Brooks in 1947 and Lynda Brooks Baker in 1948. Robbie and Harley were married 46 years.

Robbie worked for the telephone company (GTE) for 30 years. After retiring she worked at The Hale's Place and the Card Cottage in Henderson.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by two brothers James Henry Smith and Wilson Smith, sister Mary Ann Chapman, and her husband Harley.
