Robert A. (Bob) Drake, 74, of Henderson passed from this life March 9, 2014. He was born November 21, 1939 in Sweetwater, Texas to the late William A. Drake and Evelyn (Spears) Drake. Bob grew up in Lufkin and was a stand-out basketball player for Lufkin High School and after graduating went on to play for the Stephen F. Austin Lumberjacks. While attending SFA he met the love of his life and best friend Nancy (Craig) Drake. They were married June 30, 1961 and shared 52 wonderful years together. After graduating SFA they moved to Tyler where Bob started his long and successful career in the business world with Kelly Springfield Tire. While they lived in Tyler their son Robert Craig Drake was born. They then moved to Longview where he worked as an accountant for Schlitz Brewing and was with them for 15 years moving around the United States. He then became General Manager for Southwest Canning in Nacogdoches for 15 years. After moving to Henderson he was employed as accountant for Panel Truss.
