



Rev. Robert Hall

October 19, 1937 - April 30, 2013

A celebration of the life and ministry of Rev. Robert Alan Hall, 75, of Henderson, will be held at 2 pm Saturday, May 4, 2013 at First Baptist Church with Dr. David Higgs and Rev. Bill Tisdale officiating, under the direction of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home. The family will receive friends following the service in the Family Life Center at the church. A viewing will be held all day Friday at Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home. Rev. Hall went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, April 30, 2013 at his residence. He was born October 19, 1937 in New Albany, Miss. to the late E.S. and Mary Martin Hall. Robert began playing piano for church at the age of 10. His dad was a Southern Baptist pastor and he would accompany his dad to revivals, carrying his portable pump organ to play for the congregation. Robert was saved at 9 years old in the back seat of his family's 1940's Ford automobile. Robert was a graduate of Murfreesboro, Ark. high school. He attended Ouachita Baptist University, where he majored in piano and church music. Robert graduated in 1960 with a Bachelor of Music degree. During college, he served part-time in FBC Alma, Ark., and Pike Avenue Baptist, North Little Rock. He also served at Maple Avenue Baptist Church in Smackover, Ark., where he met Bettye Gray, the church pianist, who he married, and they spent 52 wonderful years together. While attending Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Ft. Worth, he served at First Baptist Church of White Settlement and graduated with a Master of Church Music degree. In September of 1967, Robert began his ministry at First Baptist Church in Henderson. He served as Minister of

Music and Youth. In 1972, he served as a Music Consultant with the Baptist General Convention of Texas for five months. He then came back to Henderson and served. He was ordained by FBC Henderson on April 18, 1980. He retired in 1996. Robert was then given the title of Minister of Music Emeritus and went back to work part-time at FBC, continuing to perform weddings, funerals, and other ministerial duties. One of his greatest joys was his visitation ministry. He loved sharing God's word and trying to meet the needs of those he visited. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother, Larry Martin Hall. Survivors include: wife, Bettye Hall of Henderson; son Greg Hall and wife Beth of Plainview; daughter, Amy Billingsley of Henderson; grandchildren, Jake Hall, Grayson Hall, Chris Sjostrom, Jessica Billingsley, and Caitlin Hall.
