



Mr. Roy Reed Boyd

September 28, 1956 - April 19, 2023

On April 19, 2023, Roy Reed Boyd died from cancer at age 66 years old. He was born in Fort Worth, TX, and graduated from Henderson High School, then from Stephen F. Austin University, and has resided in the Henderson area since 1999. His career path took him from computer programming for over 20 years, to Landman work for over a decade. He was preceded in death by his father, Bobby G. Boyd. He is survived by his mother, Kathleen Boyd, his wife, Eva Boyd, his two sisters, Kelly J. Willing and Laurin K. Williams, along with his two daughters, Vanessa Boyd and Andrea Stevens and husband Carl, and three grandchildren, Elizabeth, Olivia, and Elijah Stevens.

Roy and his wife enjoyed being members at the Bar None Cowboy Church for many years. He learned French and Greek, and was an avid biblical scholar, while also tending cows, contributing as a volunteer with the Tatum Search and Rescue, playing softball in his earlier years with American Airlines in DFW, and playing dominoes with good friends. He was well-loved and will be greatly missed.

A memorial service will be held at Bar None Cowboy Church in Tatum, TX at 11:00 a.m., Saturday, April 22, 2023, with Bro Joe Cox and Jimmy Rogers officiating.
