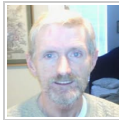

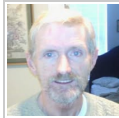
“ I am so sorry for your loss. I know this sweet lady is with the angels and the angels are laughing and playing cards with her as they keep an eye on you during this difficult time.
