Funeral services for Mr. S.O. "Sherwood" Maxwell, 94, of Minden, will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday, December 27, 2017, in the chapel at Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home with Rev. Sherwood proudly served his country in the U.S. Army, 11th Airborne Division, during World War II where he was in the South West Pacific theatre and involved in the Battle of Leyte, Battle of Luzon and the Raid at Los Banos' (Philippines), where more than 2,000 Allied prisoners were liberated. He later retired as a heavy equipment operator and he was a member of Ebenezer Baptist Church.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Lottie Dison Maxwell; granddaughter, Brittani Maxwell; and sister, Maxine Savage.
