Sandra was born in Houston, Texas on November 5, 1939 to William and Gay Pugh. She graduated from Spring Branch High School and continued her education at Kilgore College. While at Kilgore College, she was a Rangerette, a member of Chi Sigma Delta Sorority, and a Ranger Beauty.

Sandra went to be with her Lord and Savior on December 22, 2014 at home with her loving family. She was preceded in death by her parents and her sister, Carolyn Pettit. She leaves to cherish her precious memory: her husband of 55 years, Buddy Hodges; her daughters Monica Griffin and husband Jeff, and Angie Martin and husband Todd; grandchildren Shelby White and husband Ryan, Cy Moore, Hunter Martin, Nolan Griffin, and Rade Griffin; great grandson Jaxon Martin; and sister Debbie Lain and husband Charles. 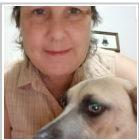
