Sharron Anne Baker, 72, peacefully passed away Sunday, October 4th, 2015, after a courageous battle with an extended illness. Sharron was born on October 22nd, 1942, in Henderson, Texas, the daughter of Bernice and Bradie Mae Alexander.

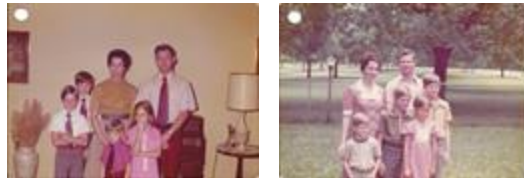
