

Mr. Steve Siler

April 10, 1956 - November 3, 2013

A celebration of the life of Steve Siler, age 57, of Henderson, Texas, will be held at the First Baptist Church of Henderson on Wednesday, November 6, 2013, at 2:00 P.M. with Dr. David Higgs officiating. Visitation will immediately follow in the First Baptist Church Family Life Center.

Steve went home to his heavenly Father on Sunday, November 3 with his wife and sons at his bedside at the Hospice of East Texas. Steve was born on April 10, 1956, in Henderson, Texas. He lived his entire life in Rusk County. Steve was a member of the First Baptist Church of Henderson where he passionately played the drums for services. He worked as an IT engineer for Rusk County Electric Co-op.

Steve loved life and lived his life to the fullest, leaving a positive impact on the lives of all those he knew. He had a passion for coaching others to reach their full potential. While his sons were young, he volunteered his time as a coach, mentor, and cheerleader for all ages of sports teams. Dear friend Michelle Wilder remembers that Steve championed "so many people in so many ways and certainly has been the Most Enthusiastic Supporter of our kids' sports teams: advised parents, mentored kids, THE authority on the best sports gear and athletic techniques, shaved a coach's head, took pictures, commentated games, painted his face for games, and entertained the team during the entire 600-mile drive to the baseball world series tournament. Steve definitely

brought the fun factor to any and all events. He was truly an awesome role model for my son and his friends."

Steve also enjoyed encouraging and coaching adults as they pursued their running goals and gave his time to train alongside his friends. His special gift was seeing the potential in an individual and devoting his time to help each person to conquer their fears in order to be the best they could be as an athlete. Amy Blanton said this about her mentor: "God brings people into your life at just the right season to teach you about yourself. Steve was that person for me. Many days while training our conversation would turn to the Lord and His love for us. Steve loved to tell how GOD has given us the ability to do more than we could ever dream. Yes, God allows people to come into our lives to better us. I am forever changed by Steve Siler's friendship."

Steve's work at Rusk County Electric Co-op, which actually began during his Radio Shack days, was not only important professionally to him, but his time with RCEC gave Steve the opportunity to make lasting relationships. Steve loved going to work each day and encouraging his co-workers through laughter and friendship. Paul Zimmerman shared that "Steve was so much fun to be around and work with. We laughed a lot, especially when he shared stories about Scott Crawford and his sometimes lack of computer expertise. Seems like every time we had food at the office - a birthday party, luncheon, or even just a box of donuts - Steve would show up. Even though working with folks who weren't quite up to speed with computer technology can be challenging, Steve always demonstrated patience and understanding."

Steve faithfully served his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ through the ministry of the Gloryland Vocal Band and the music ministry of First Baptist Church. For many years, the First Baptist drama and music ministry presented Christmas pageants for the community. Steve was the first dramatic lead, memorizing pages of script to support the scriptural dramatization of the productions, which

were seen by thousands of people throughout East Texas. The Gloryland Vocal Band was the culmination of Steve's passion for progressive Southern Gospel music. During the ten years of the Gloryland Vocal Band, Steve sang lead, played drums, engineered the sound, programmed the musical effects, and served as the heart and soul of the ministry. Steve arrived hours before concerts in order to make sure the sound and equipment were perfect so that the Lord would be honored and glorified through the ministry.

One of the joys of Steve's life, especially when he was battling cancer, was watching episodes of The Andy Griffith Show. He owned the entire collection, watched them repeatedly, and had many of the episodes memorized from beginning to end. Recently, he was made aware of his family's heritage, tracing the Siler family back to 1719 in Weimar, Germany. The family migrated to the United States and settled in Pennsylvania. From there, they moved to the Shenandoah Valley, Augusta County, Virginia, and on to Chatham County, North Carolina. While there, the family founded Siler City, which is often referenced in the Andy Griffith series. No wonder Steve felt such a connection with Andy, Barney, Goober, Gomer, and Ernest T. Bass!

Above all, Steve loved his sons, Austin and Nick, passionately and completely devoted himself to their happiness. He even sold his beloved 1969 Fastback Mustang with a 429 Super Cobra Jet Boss, the "fastest car in East Texas", when Austin was born. Steve was fearful that Austin would want to race fast and furious cars like he did during his youth. As his sons grew, Steve would stop whatever he was doing if they wanted to pass a football, shoot a basketball, or swing a bat. When Austin and Nick both showed true talent in baseball, analytical Steve bought every kind of book (and yes, Sandy has a library of baseball books), and he built a state-of-the-art batting cage and pitching mound. His ultimate desire was for them to know the Lord and to find Godly mates. When Austin married Sarah Johnson Siler, Steve truly gained a

daughter, alongside his Geneve. Obviously, Steve Siler lived a life of service that will never be forgotten by his family, friends, and community.

Survivors include wife Sandra Thompson Siler, son, Austin Siler and wife Sarah, son Nick, and very special exchange student daughter Geneve Liu Dubose; sister Rebecca Siler Young and husband Martin; brother Benny Siler and wife Lois; and numerous nieces and nephews.

Pallbearers will be Scott Crawford, Robert Ellis, Kelly Hall, Brad Keitt, Mark Mann, and Dennis Rivers.

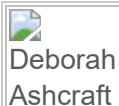
