



## Mr. Thomas Bridges

March 8, 1936 - July 15, 2014

Thomas Wesley Bridges, Sr., 78, of Laneville left this life on July 15, 2014 in Tyler, Texas.

Thomas was born March 8, 1936 in Panola County, Texas as the oldest child to Melvin and Ines (Garrison) Bridges. He attended school and graduated in 1955 from Vivian High School in Vivian, Louisiana where he was known as one of the “touchdown twins” of the high school football team. While playing for the Vivian Warriors, Thomas set several school records for speed. On March 1, 1958 he enlisted in the US Air Force in Smyrna Tennessee, where he worked as a mechanic. He was honorably discharged from the service on February 28, 1961. May 22, 1958 he married Rebecca Cooke and enjoyed family life and raising their three children. He was a line worker at Schlitz brewery for 26 years. Thomas and his family reside in Laneville, Texas, where he has enjoyed his gardening and working with his cattle, but more than anything Thomas loved having his grandchildren and great-grandchildren around him and he loved his family. He loved watching westerns, fishing, and hunting.

Thomas is survived by his wife of 56 years, Rebecca Bridges. Together they have three children Elizabeth (Liz) Holland and husband David, Thomas Wesley Bridges Jr. and wife Connie, and Charles Reese Bridges and wife Holli. Grandchildren include Wesley Bridges and wife Brandi, Josh Mosley and

wife Courtney, Hatti Bridges, and Matti Bridges. Great-grandchildren are Wyatt Mosley and Zoie Bridges; brother, Donald Bridges and wife Sandra Sue of Laneville; sister, Sandra Glass and husband Leon of Henderson. Thomas also had numerous nephews and nieces that he loved.

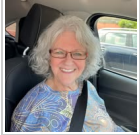

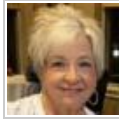
