Education: He attended Kilgore Junior College graduating with an associate degree in engineering.

Career: Right out of college he was hired by Gulf Oil in Houston and worked for them for 35 and ½ years. When he retired from there in June of 1983, he was the Director of (mainframe) Programming Education.

He loved his families, music, reading, travel, photography, and the study of genealogy. For many years his hobby was woodworking and he made beautiful furniture for his home and for family and friends. He was a licensed Ham radio operator for many years with friends all over the world.
