She loved and enjoyed riding and owning horses. Mrs. Virgie loved to tell jokes and old sayings to make others laugh and smile any time she could.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Lynn Hopson; son Robert David Hopson; and parents, Robert and Mimmie Whitfield.
