



Mr. Wayne Hyatt

August 26, 1946 - May 26, 2016

Mr. Wayne Hyatt died May 26, 2016. He worked with harness horses from the time he was a young teen. Taught at the BOCE school teaching teens to work with horses. He got his trainers and drivers license under Ezra Edes. He also worked for Harry Pawnall, Gene Pawnall, and handled Leslie Lobell for George Berkner, along with many other good horses. He was farm manager for Mr. Black of Killydonnell farm, also farm manager at Sahbra Farm for a time. He also was farm manager at Ed Ryan's farm, later opening a small private stable racing mostly at Northfield Park. He retired from racing in 1995 and came to Texas with two broodmares and raised a number of nice horses usually selling them in Canada where they had been bred to good stallions there. During this time he went to college at SFA University in Nacogdoches. He worked as a Corrections Officer in Texas prison system for a number of years until he broke his neck in a wreck.

He is survived by his wife of 32 years, Lura Hyatt; two sisters, Holly Clark of Albany N.Y. and Windy Schaffer of Corpus Christi, Texas. Step daughters Lisa Bradbury of Gary, Texas, and Penny Brooks of Henderson, Texas. A number of grandchildren and great grandchildren. He was 69 years old.
