



William E. "Bill" McCarter

Graveside services for Mr. William E. "Bill" McCarter, 89, of San Antonio, formerly of Tyler, will be held at 10 a.m. Wednesday, July 11, 2012 at New Prospect Cemetery (on the Tatum Hwy outside of Henderson) with Dr. David Dykes officiating. Interment will follow under the direction of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home in Henderson. Mr. McCarter passed away July 8, 2012 in San Antonio. He was born March 17, 1923 in Rusk County to the late John Mays and Trixie Treadwell McCarter. Bill and his wife Billie spent forty-eight years in Tyler and have spent the last three years in San Antonio. Mr. McCarter was a 1941 graduate of Henderson High School and then proceeded to serve his country in World War II in the Army Air Corps. After graduation, Bill got into the insurance business and spent his career as an insurance broker. He and Billie were members of Green Acres Baptist Church in Tyler where Bill taught Sunday School for many years. Survivors include: his wife of sixty-seven years, Billie Smith McCarter of San Antonio; son, Mays McCarter and wife Linda of San Antonio; granddaughter, Melissa Clark and husband Mike, and great-grandson, Cameron Clark, of Pearland; sister-in-law, Charlene McCarter of Henderson; brother-in-law, Paul Appleby of Tyler; and several nieces and nephews.
